OUR PURPOSE

CCI is a nine month, values-based leadership experience designed to help young Columbians (age 45 and younger):

Enhance current leadership skills and develop new ones

Identify personal core values, mission, and vision

Gain a deeper understanding of the value of relationships and collaboration

Identify community issues

Receive insight into community engagement opportunities

Understand continuous learning through networking and mentorship

Connect with community leaders

OUR EXPECTATION

To be on time and fully participate in all nine sessions which will be held from 5:00pm to 7:00pm. on the second Tuesday of each month with the exception of September. The schedule is:

September 21, 2021	December 14, 2021	March 8, 2022
October 12, 2021	January 11, 2022	April 12, 2022
November 9, 2021	February 8, 2022	May 10, 2022

Note: We understand that work and/or family commitments may cause a participant to miss a session. Participants may miss one session and still graduate. Participants are expected to inform the Moderator ahead of time.

- 2) Upon graduation, participants are expected to be involved with at least one community organization (assistance with placement is available) and to serve on a committee within the Columbia Club.
- 3) To utilize your Columbian mentor, selected specifically for each participant, for one year following graduation.

OUR VALUE

Similar leadership and skills development programs cost between \$1,200 and \$5,000. The cost is a one-time fee of \$200 (payment plan available), which may be charged to the participants Columbia Club account or paid by the participant's employer. The balance of the actual cost will be subsidized by the Columbia Club.
